SMP Research Higher Degree Milestones: Thesis Review

Research Higher Degree students are required to:

- 1. Before initiating any processes via the candidature management system talk to the Research Higher Degree Liaison Officer (Linda Waldrum) via rhd-smp@uq.edu.au
- Present their work at one of the regular SMP seminar series between mid-candidature review and thesis review. The seminar should be advertised to the School at least a week in advance. For remote candidates wishing to present their work at a conference or seminar outside of UQ, permission must be sought from the School Postgraduate Coordinator pgc-smp@uq.edu.au
- 3. Present their Advisory Team with written material of sufficient quantity and quality for a judgement to be made by the Advisory team to the SMP Postgraduate Coordinator that the thesis will be ready for submission within three months of the review.
- 4. Following step two, it is the responsibility of the Principal Advisor to provide feedback to the School Postgraduate Coordinator via email pgc-smp@uq.edu.au with a brief summary of the written material presented for the review, and with a recommendation on whether the thesis will be ready for submission within three months or not.
- If the recommendation is that the thesis will not be ready for submission within three months of the review, the student should contact the Higher Degree Liaison Officer via <u>rhd-smp@uq.edu.au</u>
- If the recommendation is that the thesis will be ready for submission within three months of the review, the student should complete an **Attainment of Milestone** through the Candidature Management Portal <u>https://my.uq.edu.au/rhd/services/manage-my-</u> <u>candidature</u>
