

SCHOOL OF MATHEMATICS AND PHYSICS SUMMER INDUSTRY EXPERIENCE 2017/18

We invite you to participate in the **School of Mathematics and Physics Summer Industry Experience Program** for 2017-18. The program provides an opportunity for undergraduate and masters students to contribute as interns to projects within your organization in the areas of statistics, mathematics, physics or cognate fields.

- Placements last for 6 to 8 weeks - up to 4 weeks in Nov/Dec 2017 and up to 4 weeks in Jan/Feb 2018.
- Students receive \$300 per week (co-funded 50% UQ / 50% industry partner).
- UQ handles contract and insurance coverage via a standard UQ sponsorship agreement
- Selection process and interviews are carried out by your organization.
- Students may have the option of doing the internship for course credit depending on their specific program of study at UQ.
- All interns will give an account of their internship experience at a UQ event in March 2018 (content subject to industry consent/IP).
- Up to **25** SMP co-funded internships are available for 2017-18.

If your organization is interested in participating, please confirm an available project with our coordinators **before Fri 11th August**. We will need a description of the project and the desired skills required for the internship.
